The Mercer Public Library (MPL) provides an unfiltered wireless internet access point for use by the public. This service is for patrons with WiFi-capable devices such as laptops, smartphones, and tablets. Individuals may need to know how to use their wireless device's configuration software to connect to the wireless network. Library staff is not allowed to configure patrons' laptops or handheld computers or install any devices or software on those computers.
